## “Does God Speak To Kids?”



### Watt's Up:

“I Know God Can Speak To Me!”



### Power Verse:

“I listen carefully to what God the Lord is saying, for he speaks peace to his faithful people...” - **Psalm 85:8**

This week we started a new series “God Speaks.” We are learning the important lesson that God not only speaks to adults, but also kids. No matter what your age, God can speak to you!

**Read:** 1 Samuel 3

### Ask:

- Who did Samuel think was speaking to him?
- Who was actually speaking to Samuel?
- Why do you think Samuel might not have thought that God was the person speaking to him?

### Say:

Sometimes, it may be easy to forget that it doesn't matter how old you are, God can still speak to you. God doesn't care if you are 7 or 70, He wants to talk to you and speak to you - you just have to listen!

### Ask:

- Why do you think we may not hear God when He is speaking to us? (Ex. We don't spend time with him, we are too busy, etc)
- What can we do to be sure we can hear God speaking to us?
- Have you ever had a time God was speaking to you - what was He saying?

### Share:

Share with your kids a time when God spoke to you as a child. If you don't have a story like that, think of someone else in your family or circle of friends who had a word from God at a young age.

### Pray:

Pray for your children that they will believe they are not too young to hear from God. If time permits, spend some time this week in quiet prayer together (maybe with worship music, etc) just trying to wait on God and listen to His voice. Model for your children that listening and waiting on God is important and easy if they make it a priority in their lives!
