So when they had come together, they asked (Jesus), “Lord, is this the time when you will restore the kingdom to Israel?” He replied, “It is not for you to know the times or periods that the Father has set by his own authority. But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, in all Judea and Samaria, and to all the ends of the earth.” ~Acts 1:6-8

“But the exact day and hour? No one knows that, not even heaven’s angels, not even the Son. Only the Father knows. “The Arrival of the Son of Man will take place in times like Noah’s. Before the great flood everyone was carrying on as usual, having a good time right up to the day Noah boarded the ark. They knew nothing - until the flood hit and swept everything away. Two men will be working in the field - one will be taken, one left behind; two women will be grinding at the mill - one will be taken, one left behind. So stay awake, alert. You have no idea what day your Master will show up. ~Matthew 24:36-42

There has been a lot of talk about the end times lately. Whether the end times were supposed to be on May 21st at 6:00 p.m. (was that Central Standard Time or Pacific?), 2012 as the ancient Mayan calendar predicted, or another time that someone throws out with whatever method they have established, we have definitive word from Jesus on the matter. The hard reality is that someday our time will come—either in a doomsday apocalypse that many fear and try to predict, or individually as we each face our own deaths over time. There is no question about it. But the reality is that NO ONE knows when that time will be. We can guess. But in the end (times), that’s all it really is. Guesswork.

But there is no guesswork about what Jesus is asking from each of us in the meantime, no matter when our end comes: we are to be God’s witnesses “to all the ends of the earth”. And this is a job that is so important and so vital that Jesus isn’t going to let us do it without help. As

PLC Preschool Registration

Paynesville Lutheran Church Preschool is a half-day preschool program. Enrollment is open to children of all Christian faiths. To be eligible, a child must turn 3, 4 or 5 years old before September 1, 2011 and be toilet trained. Classes will meet Tuesday and Thursday mornings from 8:30 - 11:00 a.m. If there is an afternoon class, it will meet Tuesday and Thursday afternoons from 12:00 - 2:30 p.m.

We also offer a Kindergarten Readiness Class on Wednesday from 8:30 - 11:00 a.m. for children going to kindergarten the following year. This class is only for students already attending the Tuesday/Thursday classes. The school year will start in early September and end in late May.

Students will be placed in the class or on a waiting list on a first-come, first-serve basis upon receipt of their completed application form, \$25 application fee and first month's tuition. Class size will not exceed 20 students. Please call the church office with any questions.
