

## Weekly Say It Verses

The Say It verses for each week are included for your reference so you can reinforce them when it applies to your lesson. Anytime you finish a minute or two early, you can go over the Say It verse aloud together a few times or ask any kids who have learned it already to recite it. A great way to improve your personal commitment to the KONNECT discipleship program would be to dedicate time each week in your personal devotional time to memorize these verses along with the kids. When you get a chance to show them what you've learned, they will be inspired and motivated by your example!

- 1 Isaiah 59:20 NLT "The Redeemer will come to Jerusalem to buy back those in Israel who have turned from their sins," says the LORD.
- 2 Luke 2:19 NLT Mary kept all these things in her heart and thought about them often.
- 3 Hebrews 4:15 NLT This High Priest of ours understands our weaknesses, for he faced all of the same testings we do, yet he did not sin.
- 4 Acts 2:38 NLT Each of you must repent of your sins and turn to God, and be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins...
- 5 Hebrews 2:18 NLT Since he himself has gone through suffering and testing, he is able to help us when we are being tested.
- 6 Matthew 16:24 NLT "...If any of you wants to be my follower, you must turn from your selfish ways, take up your cross, and follow me."
- 7 Jeremiah 32:17 NASB Ah Lord GOD! Behold, You have made the heavens and the earth by Your great power and by Your outstretched arm! Nothing is too difficult for You.
- 8 Matthew 6:6a NLT But when you pray, go away by yourself, shut the door behind you, and pray to your Father in private...
- 9 Matthew 5:41 NIV If someone forces you to go one mile, go with him two miles.
- 10 Luke 19:10 NLT The Son of Man came to seek and save those who are lost.
- 11 Luke 6:44a NLT A tree is identified by its fruit...
- 12 Matthew 25:21 NIV ..."Well done, good and faithful servant! You have been faithful with a few things; I will put you in charge of many things..."
- 13 Luke 10:42 NIV Only one thing is needed. Mary has chosen what is better, and it will not be taken away from her.
- 14 Luke 22:19 NIV He took bread, gave thanks and broke it, and gave it to them, saying, "This is my body given for you; do this in remembrance of me."

- 15 Galatians 2:20 NLT My old self has been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me...
- 16 Matthew 28:6 NIV He is not here; he has risen, just as he said. Come and see the place where he lay.
- 17 Acts 1:11 NIV "Why do you stand here looking into the sky? This same Jesus, who has been taken from you into heaven, will come back in the same way you have seen him go into heaven."
- 18 Acts 1:8 NIV "But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."
- 19 Romans 10:13 NIV "Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved."
- 20 1 John 4:8 NIV Whoever does not love does not know God, because God is love.
- 21 2 Timothy 3:12 NIV ...Everyone who wants to live a godly life in Christ Jesus will be persecuted.
- 22 2 Corinthians 5:17 NIV If anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come!
- 23 Romans 1:16 NIV I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God for the salvation of everyone who believes: first for the Jew, then for the Gentile.
- 24 Ephesians 2:18 NLT Now all of us can come to the Father through the same Holy Spirit because of what Christ has done for us.
- 25 2 Corinthians 12:9a NLT Each time he said, "My grace is all you need. My power works best in weakness."
- 26 Galatians 5:22-23 NIV The fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law.
- 27 Philippians 4:8 NLT Fix your thoughts on what is true, and honorable, and right, and pure, and lovely, and admirable. Think about things that are excellent and worthy of praise.
- 28 Revelation 21:4 NLT He will wipe every tear from their eyes, and there will be no more death or sorrow or crying or pain. All these things are gone forever.
