This means Pants and a long t-shirt. Don't worry about being hot it is typically 30 degrees cooler in the cave. In the past students have purchased clothes from goodwill and then thrown the clothes away after caving) Closed toed shoes (no open toed shoes) These shoes will get lots of red clay stain on them. Should be an old pair. **Pants** Long t-shirt flashlight
