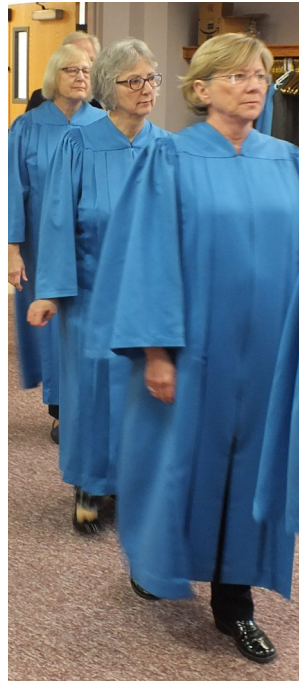

We are blessed with Alli, Tori, and Julia on our **Nursery** Caregiver Team. We are looking for a fourth team member, only because these wonderful ladies have such heavy extracurricular schedules that we sometimes need an extra person! THANK YOU to our faithful subs, Melissa Maronde, Barb Mullen, and Celine Rothaar (and, lately, also Nancy Maronde) for filling in!

NEWS: We have halted offering Nursery Care during the Sunday School hour as of late, simply because all of our Nursery age kids are currently old enough to participate in the Preschool Sunday School class. When this will change, we'll obviously expand our Nursery services again!
