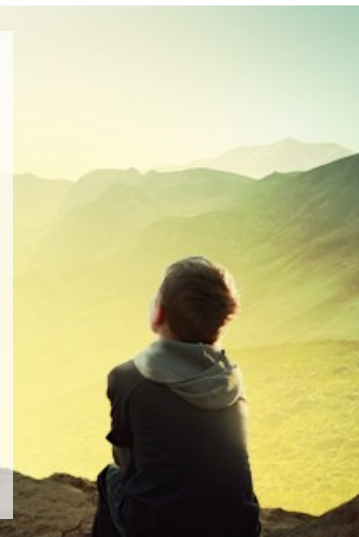

“His Word” for Your Life

The His Word devotional book gives us a great opportunity to listen to some of my favorite preachers of all time! This week’s readings in John 8-12 not only get to the heart of John’s purpose for writing, but we get to read along with Cecil May, Jr. as he thinks about what these great chapters mean. This is a great week to get caught up, or jump back in, if you’ve gotten behind. Join me, brother Cecil, and the rest of your church family in the reading this week.

1. John 8 points out the confusion the Jews have concerning freedom (see verses 33-34). As Americans, how can we be in danger of the same thing?
2. Despite the combined knowledge of the entire Jewish council, they could not penetrate one stubborn man’s simple statement: “I was blind, now I see...” What one statement can YOU hold on to that NO ONE can take away concerning your faith in Christ?
3. What lessons from John 10 does Cecil May bring out this week? What will you do about those ideas?
4. Each devotional ends with “Today I will...” and the challenge that comes with John 11 is one of the most emotionally powerful, and necessary, calls to action for anyone trying to be like Christ. Can you tackle it this week?
5. John 12 sums up the entire final week of Jesus’ life, where the other Gospels give us a few more details. John wants to take us straight to that Upper Room and the final thoughts of the Master. There are 4 amazing encounters in this chapter– which is the most powerful in your mind? Why?
