"His Word" for Your Life

This is it— the last week of reading the Story of Jesus' life and death. Chapter by chapter we've travelled this road 4 separate times— seeing different things along the way. John wants us to notice very specific things about the final days of Jesus' time on earth— especially what he says. Ed Gallagher helps us with perspective as we read in our study books, as well.

We finish John 18-21 this week, and start the first chapter in Acts...

1. Note brother Gallagher's thoughts on Jesus' arrest in John 18. How was Peter like George S. Patton in his thinking about how to 'win a war'?
2. What is the connection between Jesus' being hung "UP" on the cross, and him being exalted "on high" in John 19?
3. John 20 is both the quietest and most triumphant scene perhaps in the entire Bible. Women standing silently at a grave in the early light of morning, expecting to be alone— but instead met with the Miracle of Eternity! What do you think the walk back home for them was like that day?
4. As John finishes, he claims that his Gospel (and the other 3) are mere drops in the bucket concerning what Jesus did. What are some of the other things not covered that you would have liked to know about Jesus' life?
5. Acts 1 begins with the shortest possible recap of Jesus' ascension and the promise of the Holy Spirit. How does this mark a transition between the work of the Son and the work of the Spirit in the lives of mankind?

Gather with others this week to 'think on these' things,
and you will be blessed
