“His Word” for Your Life

You’ll notice very quickly as you read the final Gospel that John wasn’t interested in telling the same version of events in Jesus’ life! This week, we cover John 3-7. Consider the pattern of sevens— seven signs, seven sayings, etc. as they unfold in the Gospel (spoiler alert— he’ll use the same pattern at the end of the year when we read Revelation!). John wants us to see Jesus from a new perspective— and that’s very helpful for those of us who *think* we’ve got Jesus all figured out by now. Can you use ‘fresh eyes’ to consider things we read this week?

1. John 3 contains arguably the most famous verses in the whole Bible. What does William Dixon have to do with them (from the reading in His Word)?
2. In John 4 Jesus interacts with the Samaritan woman. There are many different ideas about who she was and how her life had come to this point. What do you think, and why? What matters most in this chapter to you?
3. How was the question asked in John 5 answered by the lame man? What very good point does the author in His Word make about us in connection with this situation— how can you avoid it this week?
4. Although all 4 Gospels record the miracle of feeding 5,000, what does John 6 include that we focus on during the reading this week?
5. John 7 describes Jesus inviting those at the feast to drink from living water – and then he adds something amazing. When you drink that water, you become a source of living water yourself! How do you think that happens?

Study these precious words this week, and you will *be blessed*
