Sensitive Hearts

"The sorrow that is according to the will of God produces a repentance without regret, leading to salvation." (2 Corinthians 7:10)

Can you name people today who seem to listen carefully to God—people whose hearts are especially sensitive to the Holy Spirit? I can almost guarantee that those are men and women who know what it is to be broken and bruised. They have the scars to prove it.

Perhaps as you read these words you bear the marks of a carnal week, day after day in which you've gone your own way and grieved the Spirit of God. And now you come to these pages with desperation to change in your heart—to learn from God and renew your fellowship with Him. Do you realize what's happened? Your failure has give you a sensitive, teachable spirit. It has broken the pride barrier in your life. It is what Paul called a "godly sorrow" (2 Corinthians 7:10).

"His Word" for Your Life

Ralph Gilmore, one of my favorite Bible scholars of all time, shares thoughts on Romans 9-13 in this week's readings. Can I encourage you in every way possible to read each of these difficult chapters, and follow them up with the "wonderful words of life" this good mentor shares? You won't be disappointed! Some highlights:

1. What are the three key questions in Romans 9, and what analogy does Paul use to address them?
2. The phrase "heart's desire" is a key idea in Romans 10. Given this reading, what is one of your "heart's desires" and how do you need to deal with it?
3. Romans 11 reminds us that our God is 'unsearchable'. What about this chapter brings that to light, and does that bother you? How do you deal with this issue?
4. There is a fine line between living IN our culture, and being changed BY our culture. How does Brother Gilmore remind us that Christ is to be OVER culture in Romans 12?
5. How does Brother Gilmore tie three different sections of Scripture together in the key of Romans 13:8? What does God want from YOU?

These are the central chapters in Paul's greatest letter— don't let their difficulty chase you away! Think about each of these chapters, and gather with others this week to talk about them. You will be blessed!
