"His Word" for Your Life

Our history lessons in the New Testament are drawing to an end— we read Acts 22-26 this week, and turn to the letters of the New Testament next. It is *critical* for us to know these historical facts in order to correctly interpret the things we will read in Paul's letters to the churches we have been introduced to during our study of Acts. Remember that this was all new information for the young church— They believed in Jesus, but didn't know how to put all of his teachings to good use. They needed the Apostles to help guide them— and that provides the context for Paul's missionary trips to them as well as the letters we still lean on for authority today. Consider these points as you read:

1. In Acts 22, Paul defends his life and actions by telling his personal story. What is your personal story of faith? How can you share it with others?
2. We meet Paul's nephew in Acts 23, and only know this one thing about him. What lesson from today's devo in "His Word" do you take from this?
3. Every day's devotional thought ends with "Today I will..." Can I encourage you to make a special effort to pay attention to them this week— especially today with Acts 24? They are very powerful things to consider— and to do!
4. How do the events in chapter 25 fulfil Paul's vision of going to Rome?
5. Think about Paul's words in Acts 26:29. Could you say the same thing about yourself?

Think about each of these chapters, and gather with others this week to talk about them. You will *be blessed!*
