"His Word" for Your Life

What a blessing the "His Word" book has been for us already this year! I hope you are reading one chapter in the New Testament each weekday, and taking a few moments to let that word sink into your mind and heart. Michael Moss wrote the devotionals each day for Luke 17-21 and he packs them with good 'points to ponder'! This week you will walk with Jesus as he continues teaching, and see his entry into Jerusalem through Luke's eye. What does Luke take time to point out to you? "Think on these things" this week:

1. Luke 17 has one of my favorite verses about how the apostles responded to Jesus and his teaching because it sounds just like me. Can you find it?
2. Luke 18 has a little bit of everything— parables, dealings with the elite (rich man) and the outcast (children, beggars), and prophecies concerning his upcoming sacrifice. Just how busy do you think Jesus' days were?
3. There certainly must have been some highs and lows for Jesus in Luke 19. How do you think he handled/looked at the ups and downs of each day?
4. Luke 20 showcases how Jesus dealt with those who tried to challenge him. How is his reaction to them different than, say, how he treated Zacchaeus?
5. Luke 21 has been called one of the most difficult chapters in the Bible. Given that Jesus himself specifically points out that it deals with the destruction of the Temple (see verses 6, 9, 20, and 32), what could the confusing parts in verses 25-28 mean?

Spend some time with others in God's Word each day,
and you will *be blessed!*
