His Word for Your Life

After Luke begins his Gospel sharing the reason and sources for his work (Luke 1:1-4), he carries us through several memorable moments in Jesus' childhood (at least Mary thought they were worth remembering— Luke 2:19, 51). There is more discussion of his family heritage, followed by his first temptations, disciples, and sermons. By the end of this week's reading, we have Jesus firmly in place as an important teacher— but later reading will reveal him to be so much more!

"Think on these things" as you read this week:

1. Luke 2 shares the only event in Jesus' childhood recorded in the Bible. What other information would you like to be able to read from Jesus' early years? Why do you think more isn't said about them?
2. Chapter 3 could be called Jesus' family— John the Baptist and the family tree of Christ. Pick one name from the list and see what you can learn about them— picturing their life might shed light on interesting things!
3. Where in chapter 4 is the first hint that Jesus will not always be received well when preaching? How does it foreshadow the end to come?
4. What does Luke 5:24 teach us about the reason for miracles?
5. What seems to be the emphasis of Luke's version of the Sermon on the Mount, when he shortens it to less than 1 chapter?

Spend some time with others in God's Word each day,
and you will be blessed!
