**Luke 10:30-37:** When Jesus taught this parable describing our neighbor, he said nothing about the “religious affiliation” of the man in the parable who fell among thieves and NEEDED HELP. Neither did He mention his race, age, education, income, marital status, character, etc., because it didn’t matter!! As God’s people, it’s not who is a neighbor to us, but to whom of God’s creation we are a neighbor. “Go, and do thou likewise” (Luke 10:37). “As we have opportunity, let us do good to all men, especially unto them who are of the household of faith.” (Galatians 6:10).

## “His Word” for Your Life

One chapter each day. That’s all it takes to get through the whole New Testament in a year. As a family, we’ve set the goal to make it happen— and so many of us are still on track. It seems so fitting that here at Easter we conclude Luke’s Gospel and read about the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus. We’ll also get into John’s very different account of the life of Christ at the end of the week, and Doug Burleson has great thoughts for us to consider as we read. Here are some other questions to notice as you do-

1. Luke 22 is the only chapter that points out what Jesus does the very moment Peter realizes he has fulfilled the prophecy to deny him. How do you imagine that went? What do you think Jesus looked like?
2. I read at least 7 specific individuals— a few without given names— who interacted with Jesus in Luke 23. Which one are you most like, and why?
3. Luke 24 appears to say Jesus ascended into Heaven the day he was raised from the dead— but Acts 1:3 says he spent 40 days teaching them between these two events. How can you reconcile this apparent conflict?
4. Matthew traces Jesus’ heritage back to Abraham, and Luke goes back even farther to Adam. Where does John take us back to concerning the origins of Jesus?
5. John 2 demonstrates the power and authority of Jesus immediately, as he performs his first miracle and cleanses the temple. What power and authority will you give Jesus over your life today?

Study these precious words this week, and you will *be blessed!*
