Genesis 21-22

1. Read Genesis 22:1-19. Share your biggest highlight or takeaway after hearing the sermon or from reading this passage on your own.
2. In Genesis 22 we find that our God tests His children. Do you think this attribute of God is often discussed or commonly neglected in our Christian circles? Why or why not?
3. Discuss a time in your life or the life of a neighbor when faith was put to the test. What did you learn about yourself and man's relationship to God from the event?
4. Christ commands His followers to forsake all they treasure most (see Luke 14:26-27). Discuss the impact this command has on the way we think about the Christian way of life. What can we learn from the example of Abraham on this topic?
5. Look up James 2:21-23. What significance does the Abraham and Isaac story have for James' argument? Discuss the relationship between true faith and works.
6. Share a "Mt. Moriah moment" with the group. How has the Lord provided for you? What could you do to memorialize that moment so that you will remember it always?
7. Read Romans 8:31-39. How can these words encourage us in the truth that God always keeps His promises?
