



## Aprons for Nicaragua

The ladies of Nicaragua wear aprons on a daily basis. This is a much-needed item for them. Our initial plan is to make two aprons for the lady of the household for each home our mission team will be helping build. Each lady will receive a simple daily wear apron with a little flair.

Kits for making aprons at home are available in the foyer.

Connect through a Photo. As you finish your apron, pray over it one more time. Please slip a photograph of you and the apron in the apron pocket. While we do not share a common spoken language, the recipient will understand that you, as an individual, cared enough about her to make this apron for her.

**In addition to your time and talents, we are also accepting donations including:**

- Fabric: lightweight fabrics suitable for aprons including cotton, broadcloth, gingham, duck, and other lightweight woven fabrics. (1 yard or larger lengths of fabric are desirable.)
  - Ribbon, lace, rick rack, trim, etc. suitable for use on aprons
  - Monetary donations topurchase needed supplies will also be accepted.
- Prayer. Pray for the “Aprons for Nicaragua” project and the mission team going to Nicaragua, and for the individual women receiving the aprons.
