PBC Members Help with Tornado Disasters in Kansas and Missouri

Emo and Ina Brawley and Jack Flippo are part of the Disaster Relief Team with Kansas Nebraska Convention of Southern Baptists (KNCSB). They were called out early this week to assist the people that were hit by the tornado in Reading, KS. All three of them are helping with the Feeding Unit in Emporia, KS at the Twelfth Avenue Baptist Church. There, they are preparing meals and the Red Cross is taking them to Reading to feed approximately 450 people, 3 times a day.



Allen Dawson, along with John Hoefer from First Presbyterian Church and Colin Eaton from Praise Assembly of God church in Derby bought some bottled water at Sam's Club and took it to Joplin, Missouri to help with the disaster relief efforts there. They filled up the church van and trailer with over 200 cases of water containing about 6000 water bottles. The supplies were delivered to Galena Assembly Church in Galena, KS and Forest Park Baptist Church in Joplin, MO. Pray for the residents of Joplin as this devastating tornado will require months and years to recover from.
