2013 Hands-On Mission Project will be health kits that will go to Liberia and Zimbabwe. Each kit should contain the ingredients listed below in the exact sizes where listed due to customs' inspections (if incorrect that stops the shipment). Please DO NOT substitute ingredients or add extra ingredients to the kits. Deadline for the kits is June 2nd. There will be a table in the hallway outside of the Sanctuary by the Prayer Room where you can place your health kit for Pleasant View. Sunday school classes, groups or individuals can participate in this mission project. Abingdon District has been asked to provide a minimum of 300 health kits. Let us help meet this goal! Pleasant View is also the drop off site for the kits so please put your kits on the table so we can get an accurate count of how many PV does. Thank you!!!

Health Kits Ingredients are: 2 bars soap

1 washcloth

1 small bottle Listerine\*

2 tubes toothpaste (6.4 oz or smaller)

2 toothbrushes

1 bottle children's cough syrup (small)

1 bottle Aleve\* (24 count)

1 bottle Advil\* (24 count)

1 bottle children's chewable aspirin or Tylenol\* (30 count or fewer)

\* Generic is acceptable

Pack all items in a 2 gallon zip lock bag. Please tape \$5 in a separate envelope for shipping on the outside of the bag. Do not put money or checks inside kits. Thank you!
