Mission Focus: Our stated mission is to express our worship of God and our growing knowledge of God's love in the ways we reach out to the hurting members of our community. We start with Blanket Sunday in February - a PW offering benefitting Church World Service. In March, we have the Widow's Mite to benefit Emergency Aid. In April there is One Great Hour of sharing. In May, 40% of the Pentecost Offering is kept locally towards our Mission Possible. Over the summer, we gather clothing items for school children who might need help with emergency clothing. This project is presented to the schools in August. In September we have our Peacemaking Offering as a Peace and Global Witness. We end the year with our Angel Tree and the Christmas Joy Offering. This year, the Angel Tree was dedicated to the eleven members of our local Circles Out Of Poverty group, here in Great Bend. We raised \$275 to provide gift certificates for these striving individuals.
