On Sunday, March 9, 2014 the Sterling UPC church service was led by the youth attending the PSK Youth Council's Sleep "Less" in Sterling annual event held at Sterling College. Youth Council asked Sterling UPC if they might hold their final session of the event at the

church. This provided the congregation with an opportunity to get to know Presbyterians from across the state. This was also a chance to hear from the next generation of Christians, both in regard to what energizes them about the church, as well as, their vision for the church in coming years.

During Sleep "Less" participants created Zombie Survival Kits (PDA Hygiene Kits). According to Joe Wiseman, Youth Director, Covenant Presbyterian, Wichita, those youth gathered were reminded through the story of Lazarus, that when Jesus called, to Lazarus he said, "Lazarus come out!" and when Lazarus did come forward Jesus told the people to unbind Lazarus from his grave clothes.
