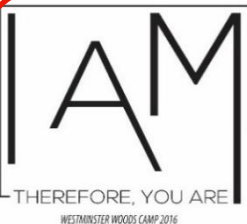

The annual business meeting and spring gathering of the Presbyterian Women of Southern Kansas was held Saturday, April 16, 2016, Presbyterian Church, Marion. The theme for the day was "Streams of Mercy-Forgiveness." Fifty-nine members and guests representing 14 churches were in attendance.

The Marion County Food Bank was recipient of the offering. A representative of the Food Bank reported on its ministries. The Rev. Angela Madden Scott, FPC, Winfield, led us in morning worship and Holy Communion.

The Rev. John Haspels and his wife, Gwen, retired missionary co-workers, were introduced. They shared a video and spoke of their work with the Suri tribe in Ethiopia, East Africa. They recounted the October 2014 ordeal when they were both shot by a man with an AK-47. They told of their forgiveness for the shooter and praised God for all the helpers that came their way during their recovery. The morning worship offering was designated for the Haspels to continue the work with the Suri people.



During the business meeting, coordinating team members were elected and the Rev. Angela Madden Scott installed them. The 2015 financial report and the proposed budget for 2017 was approved. An honorary life membership in Presbyterian Women, PC(USA) was presented to Sandra Larson, Moderator, Presbyterian Women of Southern Kansas.
