"Team Presby" had a total of twenty-one willing workers at the Kansas Food Bank on Wed afternoon March 22. Eleven youth and three adults from FPC Wichita were joined by seven volunteers from the Wichita Korean congregation.

In just two hours the team filled 135 cases, that's 1,088 individual backpacks, for the week-end Food4Kids project. This food is distributed each Friday school is in session to 7,000 food insecure students in 400 schools in 58 Kansas communities, 1,800 backpacks stay in Sedgwick County.
