Dear Parents,

Your child has expressed an interest in applying for the Presbytery of Southern Kansas Youth Council (PSKYC). We would like to make sure that you are aware of the level of commitment that is required of members selected for PSKYC.

PSKYC plans at least two events each year. Westminster Wood Work Weekend which will take place in November and Sleepless in Sterling which will take place in March of each year. Your child would be required to attend these events. In addition, we meet four or five other times throughout the year in order to plan the events. The meetings are also mandatory.

We try to change where we meet based on where the youth are from. For instance we may have the August meeting at Westminster Woods, the September meeting in Wichita, and the January meeting in El Dorado. These are just examples, but we want you to be aware of the amount of driving that could be involved.
