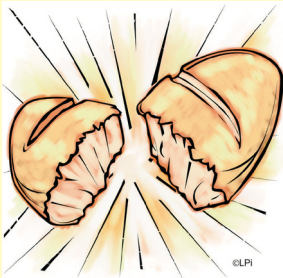

Stewardship Reflection The Transfiguration of the Lord

The Book of Daniel, from which our First Reading is drawn, was written some two centuries before the birth of Christ. This is only significant in the many of the prophets (Daniel is considered one of the major prophets) lived as many of six centuries before Christ. However, regardless the timeline, we need to be moved by and appreciative of the prophecies we find in the Old Testament. In the particular passage in today's reading it states, "The one like a Son of Man received dominion, glory, and kingship."

Today, of course, is the Feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord, and this reading very much parallels what is portrayed in the Transfiguration. The interesting point within this reading from Daniel, however, is that it refers to the "Son of Man," which is the term Jesus Himself used most often to describe Himself.

We have referenced this fact previously. In fact, the term "Son of Man" occurs 85 times in the Gospels, and in 83 of them it is Jesus who uses the term. (It appears 32 times in Matthew; 15 times in Mark; 26 times in Luke; and 12 times in John, and it is in John where it is used twice by someone other than Jesus.)

The important point for us is that Jesus calling Himself the Son of Man explains that He was born of a woman, and He shares in our earthly conditions and sufferings. That fact should make us want to embrace Him as our Savior, our Friend, and our Shepherd even more.

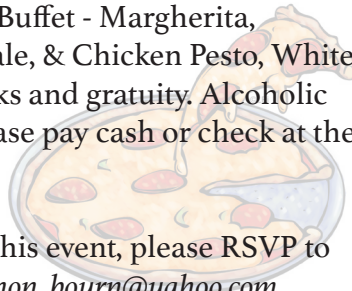

Reflexión - La Transfiguración del Señor

El libro de Daniel, de donde sale nuestra Primera Lectura, fue escrito dos siglos antes del nacimiento de Cristo. Esto es significativo en que muchos de los profetas (Daniel es considerado uno de los profetas mayores) vivieron hasta seis siglos antes de Cristo. Sin embargo, independientemente de la línea de tiempo, deberíamos de ser movidos y agradecidos de las profecías que encontramos en el Viejo Testamento. En un pasaje en particular de la Lectura de hoy dice, “Vi algo como un Hijo de hombre que venía sobre las nubes del cielo, se dirigió hacia el anciano y lo llevaron a su presencia. Se le dio el poder, la gloria, y la realeza, y todos los pueblos, naciones y lenguas lo sirvieron.”

Hoy es la Fiesta de la Transfiguración del Señor, y esta lectura es muy similar a lo que se retrata en la Transfiguración. El punto interesante dentro de esta lectura de Daniel es que se refiere al “Hijo del Hombre”, que es el termino que Jesús mismo uso con más frecuencia para describirse a sí mismo.

Hemos referenciado a este hecho anteriormente. De hecho, el término “Hijo del Hombre” ocurre 85 veces en los Evangelios, y en 83 de ellos es Jesús quien usa el termino.

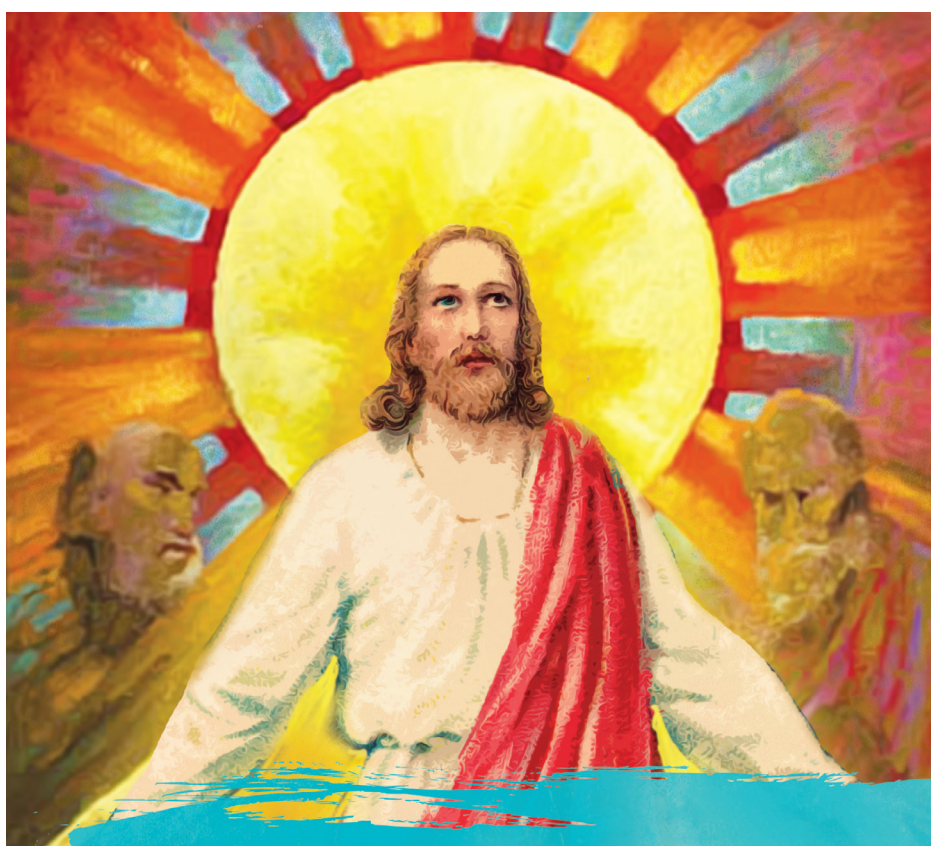
El punto importante para nosotros es que Jesús llamándose el mismo el Hijo del Hombre explica que El nació de una mujer, y el comparte en nuestras condiciones y sufrimientos terrenales. Ese hecho debe hacernos querer abrazarlo como nuestro Salvador, nuestro Amigo, nuestro Pastor aun más.
