



Casting Lots for the Seamless Garment (John 19:23-24) Death Penalty Repealed

Annapolis, MD. - The Maryland House of Delegates passed legislation March 15 to repeal the state's death penalty in what the Maryland Catholic Conference called "a historic moment."

The conference advocates for public policy measures on behalf of the state's Catholic Bishops, who are longtime supporters of repealing the death penalty. The House passed the bill with a vote of 82 to 56 and the Senate passed the bill in February. The bill now goes to Gov. Martin O'Malley, who has promised to sign it into law. Maryland is the 18th state to repeal the death penalty, and the first state below the Mason-Dixon Line to do so. (National Catholic Reported, Mar 29 - Apr 11)
