Capital Punishment in Alabama

Capital punishment is legal in **Alabama**, as it is in most U.S. states. Capital punishment dates back to 1812, when present day Alabama was still part of the Mississippi Territory.

Intentional murder with any of 18 aggravating factors can be charged as capital murder. Like Delaware and Florida, Alabama allows trial judges to overrule a jury's decision; nearly 100 have been sentenced to death since 1976 as a result of a judicial sentencing override. Executions are carried out at the Holman Correctional Facility, near Atmore, Alabama.

Fifty one people have been executed by the state of Alabama since 1983 (24 by electrocution and 27 by lethal injection).

As of July 2011, there are 205 people on the state's death row. As in any other state, people who are under 18 at the time of commission of the capital crime or mentally challenged are nationally exempt from execution. The Governor of Alabama has the authority to grant a commutation of sentence in capital (as well as non-capital) cases. There has been only one commutation of a death sentence since 1976... by outgoing Governor Fob James in January 1999.
