Progressive Baptists Support Hillary Clinton's call for Universal, Automatic Voter Registration

She urged Congress to restore key sections of the <u>Voting Rights Act</u>, which the Supreme Court invalidated. <u>Shelby County vs. Holder</u> decision that stripped the Voting Rights Act, the PNBC and key lawmakers will gather in Washington, D.C. to urge Congress to take immediate action to ensure that all Americans will have a strong and reconstituted Voting Rights Act.
