Conference Guidelines and Directives

CHAPERONE SELECTION — Each church must designate chaperones for both male and female youth. There must be one chaperone in each room for youth 18 and under. Minimum age requirement is 25 for chaperone. Must be in good health and stamina, a considerable amount of physical activity is a necessity.

- * Should know Jesus Christ as their personal Savior
- * Should love God, and people—both young and old
- * Communicate well with others
- * Be flexible; humble and willing to handle crisis
- * A good listener as well as an encourager.
- * Be patient; kind; tolerant; and long-suffering.
- * A light sleeper
- * Able to work well under pressure and be objective.

CHAPERONE RESPONSIBILITY — The chaperone will have direct responsibility for their group, as well as working with other chaperones during group functions. They will be expected to reside in the room with their youth, to accompany and supervise students to classes, worship and other activities as needed.

Code of Conduct

- As a PARTICIPANT you take full responsibility for any damage you cause to the property. We ask that you respect the hotel property and other guest. Adult chaperones from your church are assigned to a group of participants. Please stay with your church chaperone or make sure that he/she knows where you are at all times.
- 2. All adult leaders are your chaperones. Be respectful and obedient to all adult leaders.
- Participants are expected to attend all conference activities. Remember: NAME TAGS/BANDS are to be worn at all times in order to be admitted to all activities.
- 4. Youth who cause problems will be reported to their pastor. If necessary, parents will be notified and youth will be sent home.
- 5. You cannot leave the premises for any reason whatsoever without the permission of your chaperone. If something needs to be done, please ask your chaperone or a conference member. If you need change, please check with the front desk or the conference coordinator. If you lose something please check with the conference coordinator.
- 6. Please place all trash in the proper containers. If you notice a liquid spill, please notify the conference coordinator or front desk at once!
- 7. NO, NO, NO, talking during presentations, unless discussion is asked for.
- 8. Stay in your seats during presentations/activities/worship service unless it is an emergency.
- If you are taking any prescription medication, please register and leave them with your chaperone. If at any time, you
 feel ill, please let your chaperone know.
- NO Public Display of Affection. (Making out).
- 11. The purchase, possession or consumption of beer, wine, other alcoholic beverages, or tobacco products by minors and the possession or use of illegal drugs by any individual will not be tolerated. These are state laws, which must be obeyed. Infraction of these rules will mean immediate dismissal from the Conference. The hotel bars and lounges are OFF LIMITS unless you are there with your chaperone purchasing food.
- 12. Shirts and shoes must be worn at all times when not in your hotel room or in the pool area. NO shorts, nor sleepwear may be worn outside your room.
- 13. Socializing prior to curfew should be done in the public areas of the hotel since noise levels must be kept to a minimum in the sleeping areas. This guarantees the right to privacy and to peace and quiet, for not only fellow activity attendees, but also other guests who may be staying in the hotel at the time. Please be respectful of these other persons and use rooms for sleeping, not for visiting.
- 14. No visiting is allowed in rooms by members of the opposite sex unless an adult chaperone is present.
- 15. Follow water safety rules when in the swimming pool. No running or horseplay around the pool is permitted. Follow all posted guidelines in pool areas. For your safety in case you choose to swim, understand that there is no lifeguard and you are swimming at your own risk and will follow basic water safety rules when in the swimming pools.
- 16. Please refrain from "joy riding" on the elevators. Please do not overcrowd elevators.
