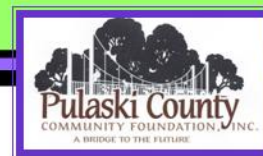

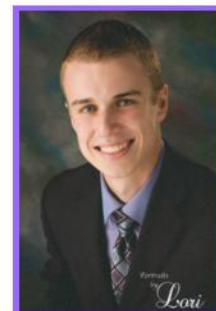


Would you like an opportunity to “give back”?

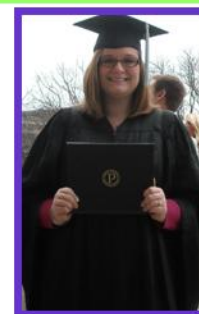
