Alberta J. Barnhouse Memorial Teacher Scholarship – *Winamac Community High School graduates majoring in teacher education.*

Bowden Family Student Athlete Scholarship – *Pulaski County residents graduating from Winamac Community High School who have participated in varsity level sports and plan to continue athletic pursuits at a 2 or 4 year accredited college/university.*

Linda L. Keys Braun Memorial Scholarship – *Winamac Community High School seniors with financial need*

Katherine L. Brown Scholarship & Achievement Award – *Winamac Community High School seniors who have attained the highest degree of academic and other achievements.*

Thomas E. and Ola M. Carneal Scholarship – *Graduating seniors of any public high school in Pulaski County with a priority for students entering nurse's training.*

Marshall and Lola Carper Scholarship – *Winamac Community High School seniors who have attained awards and achievements.*

Don Chapman Creative Writing Memorial Scholarship – *Winamac Community High School seniors, resident of Pulaski County for past 4 years, in good standing, and shows potential in creative writing.*

Brian D. Conn Memorial Music Scholarship – *Pulaski County residents graduating from any public high school pursuing a degree in music.*

Conn Family Scholarship Award – *Winamac Community High School graduating seniors who have the highest GPA in combined high school math/science classes.*

Jim Dobson Memorial Scholarship – *Winamac Community or West Central High School graduating seniors seeking a degree in the music or automotive field.*

Franklin and Evelyn Fechner Scholarship – *Winamac Community High School seniors pursuing education in the field of Engineering.*

John M. & Marjean Fritz Memorial Scholarship – *Winamac Community High School graduating seniors representing good citizenship and character.*

Galbreath Scholarship – *Winamac Community or West Central High School seniors entering the field of Music, Vocational, or Liberal Arts. Renewable.*

Alexandra (“Ali”) Gibson Memorial Scholarship – *Pulaski County residents graduating from Winamac Community or West Central High School entering the field of Speech/Language Pathology, Special Education, or Elementary Education.*

Giving Back Scholarship – *Awarded to a finalist in the LECS process.*

Bob Goble Memorial Scholarship – *Pulaski County residents graduating from Winamac Community High School and who exhibit good character and citizenship.*

William O. (Billy) Goble Memorial Scholarship – *Winamac Community High School seniors with financial need.*

Good Oil/BP Healthcare Scholarship – *Pulaski County residents attending any Pulaski County high school and pursuing a degree in the field of Healthcare.*

Don O & Mary M Good Memorial Scholarship – *Tippecanoe Township residents that will graduate in the top 50% of class with a B or C average and in good standing.*

Agnes Hartman Scholarship – *Tippecanoe Township residents that will graduate in top 40% of class and displays good character.*

Tom Hoover Memorial Scholarship- *graduates of any Pulaski County high school who plan to study in the field of automotive, engineering, vocational, or nature/conservation.*

Ralph E. and Sarah M. Horner Scholarship – *Winamac Community High School seniors; includes financial need.*

Everett and Ethel Knebel Scholarship – *For Van Buren Township graduating seniors. Renewable.*

Lilly Endowment Community Scholarship – *Pulaski County high school seniors who will have graduated by the end of June from a regionally accredited Indiana high school and who have been accepted to pursue a full-time baccalaureate course of study at an accredited public or private college or university in Indiana.*

Roland and Nancy Lowry Memorial Scholarship – *Winamac Community High School seniors who have attended all 4 years and are Pulaski County residents; includes financial need.*

Community Foundation Scholarship- *Winamac or West Central High School Pulaski County seniors entering any field of study at a post-secondary school, trade school, public or private.*

Francis and Gertrude Rausch Agricultural Scholarship – *West Central or Winamac Community High School seniors with financial need and an interest in Agriculture and/or Ag sciences. Renewable.*

Judge Jack Richert Memorial Scholarship – *Winamac Community High School graduating seniors.*

Earl D. Roudebush Memorial Scholarship – *Winamac Community High School graduating seniors who have participated in athletics.*

Senn Family Scholarship – *graduating senior from a Pulaski County high school majoring in Agriculture or ag-related field attending an accredited 2 or 4 year public or private institution of higher learning.*

Albert Lee Weaver Memorial Scholarship – *Graduating seniors of Winamac Community High School entering the field of Agriculture or Nursing.*

Winamac Rotary Club Scholarship - *Winamac Community High School seniors who have demonstrated participation in community service outside of school.*

Nontraditional Scholarships

Back Home Again in Indiana Scholarship - *Applicants must be at least 21 years of age, enrolled in or applying to a training program or accredited college or university, be a resident of Pulaski County, and in need of financial assistance.*

K. Stuart Gast Scholarship – *Open to college students who are Pulaski County residents, have attended a public high school and are interested in the arts, enrolled at Butler University, Indiana University or Herron School of Art & Design.*

Gary M. Schnapf Memorial 4-H Scholarship – *Applicants will be Fulton County residents who plan to enroll in their sophomore or junior year of college, and 10-year 4-H Dairy members. 10-year 4-H members will also be considered.*

Ralph E. Winters Scholarship – *Eligible applicants will be Culver Community High School graduates enrolled full-time in their sophomore year or above in a technical program.*
