LIFE GROUP CURRICULUM

CONNECTION QUESTION:

Share with the group some of your favorite family memories, either growing up or now? What made those memorable?

GO DEEPER:

This week we continue in our series entitled “30 Days to Easter”. We are on a four week journey to the cross where Jesus was crucified. Last week we discussed how Jesus’ life compels us to finish strong. This week we are going to explore what it means to walk with Jesus on a daily basis. Lets take a closer look together.

1. Take a moment to discuss this weekend’s message and what stood out to you the most.
2. What are some ways that we can walk in worship with God on a daily basis? Share with the group some things that can hinder us from walking in worship with God daily.
3. Read Romans 12:3 & Ephesians 4:1-2. Why do you think Paul places such an emphasis on being humble? What can we learn from Jesus’ humility?
4. Read Romans 12:2. What does Paul mean by ‘patterns of this world’? What do you think he means when he says, ‘renewing our minds’?
5. Read Romans 12:6-8. Describe to the group what some of your spiritual gifts are and how you are currently using those gifts. If you aren’t sure, what are some of the things you really enjoy doing for other people? How can you use those passions within the church?
6. Explain whether or not you believe you are a part of a family at Radiant church. If so, what makes you feel that way. If not, why not?

FOR PERSONAL STUDY:

Deeper Reflection - Living Sacrifice/Holiness

1. Read 1 Peter 2:5. What is Peter trying to explain to the people in this passage? What does it mean to be a holy priesthood?
2. Read Hebrews 10:19-22. How was Jesus' sacrifice for us provide an example of how we can be sacrifices today for others? How does Jesus' blood cleanse us? How does this passage relate to 1 Peter 2:5?
3. Read Romans 6:19-22. What does Paul mean in verse 22 when he says, "the benefit you reap leads to holiness"? What does holiness mean to you? How would that look in your daily life?
4. Read Hebrews 12:14. What is meant by "without holiness no one will see the Lord"? How does this relate to what Paul says in Romans 6:19-22?
