The Big Idea: Jesus teaches us to love others even if they are very different than us.

Key Words

PRIEST...

...a person of a religious group who performs sacred duties and acts as a mediator between God and humans. Priests concerned themselves with following the laws of God.

LEVITE...

...similar to a priest, this religious leader worked in the temple. All priests were Levites, but not all Levites were priests.

SAMARITAN...

...a person from Samaria. Even though they believed in the same God, Jews and Samaritans disliked each other.

NEIGHBOR...

...a person we are called to love. Anyone and everyone can be called our neighbor.
