Why does the pastor shake someone's hand before and after the service? The pastor shakes the hand of an elder at the beginning and end of the service. It is a sign that our worship services are conducted under the oversight of the consistory (i.e. the pastors & elders of the church). One of the main duties of an elder is to oversee corporate worship and maintain the purity of the Word and sacraments. Be thankful for that! And know that this is a sign of that oversight. It's a sign that this church is not the pastor's church or the elders' church, but that it is Christ's church and He shepherds us through the ordained pastors and elders of His church.

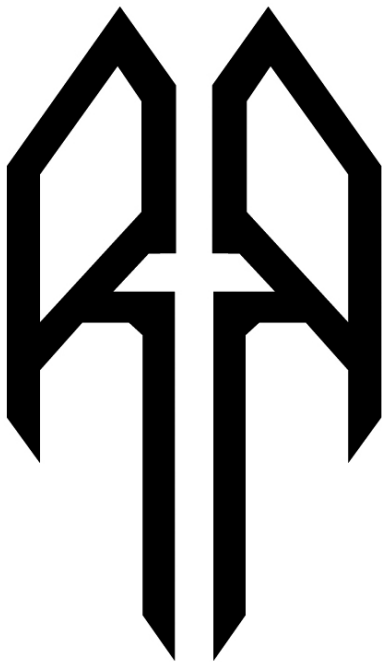
