## Visitor FAQs

### *Why does the pastor raise his hands?*

The Bible teaches that worship is a dialogue between God and His people. God speaks to us by His Word and we respond in prayer and song. When the pastor raises his hands it is a symbol that God is speaking to His people through His minister of His Word. (see Numbers 6:23-27; Leviticus 9:22; Luke 24:50-51)

### *Are you Catholic?*

Yes and no. No we are not Roman Catholic. We are a Protestant church. But yes, we are catholic in the sense that we believe Christ has a universal church (this is what the word catholic means).

## Heidelberg Catechism, Lord's Day 46

**120 Q. Why has Christ commanded us to address God as “our Father”?** A. To awaken in us at the very beginning of our prayer what should be basic to our prayer—a childlike reverence and trust that through Christ God has become our Father, and will much less refuse to give us what we ask in faith than will our parents refuse us the things of this life.<sup>1</sup>

**121 Q. Why the words “who is in heaven”?** A. These words teach us not to think of God's heavenly majesty in an earthly way,<sup>1</sup> and to expect from his almighty power everything needed for body and soul.<sup>2</sup>


