SUMNER ELEMENTARY PARTNERSHIP

In the early 2000's the Western North Carolina Conference and the United Methodist Women recognized the need for volunteers to help in elementary schools. Through the Bishop's Initiative on Children and Poverty, they hired a former teacher, Sandra Honeycutt to develop a plan to train volunteers to help in the classroom. Sandra's plan, Hand in Hand, held training workshops throughout the district. A workshop here at Rehobeth allowed teachers from Sumner to attend and we got their feedback. This partnership has worked very well.

Through the years we have had many volunteers working in classrooms and many more have helped proctor during testing. Presently, we have five people who help weekly in a classroom: Frankie Kallam, Joan Landreth, Dave Winfree, Mary Beth Winfree and Nancy Short. We are grateful that Jim and Susan Rollins have recently volunteered to help this year and will begin shortly. In addition to volunteering, we also collect school supplies each fall for Sumner, our Mission Wagon offering is designated for Sumner one month a year, we have had a mitten tree at Christmas for the students, and the United Methodist Women give them \$100 a year. They also pack 15 backpacks each week to send home with children who would likely have food needs over the weekend. The Adults for Christ give them \$450 a year and adopt a Sumner family at Christmas. We also ask the congregation to "pick an apple" with a teacher's or staff member's name on it and pray for them and all the children who that person will come in contact with each day. Sumner now has a food pantry and a children's clothes closet for their families who need assistance. If you would like to contribute to either of these needs, please place your food and clothes in the baskets in the side vestibules. Monetary contributions will also be accepted.

Many people in our congregation attended Sumner School when it was grades 1-12 and many more when it became an elementary school.

Thank you for all you do to help Sumner Elementary School.
