# Khan Academy Summer Math Review 2016



Hello Parents & Students,


Congratulations on another great school year in the books! Now it's time to rest up for the next year, but let's make sure to keep up our math skills. The math department has decided together what we think are the most important skills to review from each class. Each student has been walked through this process with their teacher during class to make sure students understand how to do their review work this summer. This is a detailed document to explain how the program works. Hopefully we answer all of your questions!

#### Log In:

- Students will log into their Gmail account (Restoration Academy emails) and click on the Google classroom link.
- Each student has been assigned a Google class according to the class they just completed. (Ex: They just finished Geometry then they will be in the Geometry summer review)

## **Objectives:**

- Each class will have between 16 to 20 objectives to complete over the course of the entire summer.
- On the Google classroom stream the students can see when each objective is due. The first half will be due by July 1st, and the second half will be due by August 5th. (School starts back on August 10th)




#### How to access your Khan Academy:

• Click on the link for the objective you are trying to complete. It will lead you straight to the practice questions we want you to complete for that section.

 Look in the top right corner of the screen; make sure you are LOGGED IN so we can see that you did all the work!

- YOU must complete a MINIMUM of 20 practice questions for each objective.
- After you have practiced one section it will lock you out of that section for 24 hours before you may complete a mastery challenge.




- You may continue on to another objective to complete practice problems.
- IF you wait until the day all of the objectives are due you will NOT be able to finish because the system locks you out for a minimum of 24 hours. DO NOT WAIT UNTIL THE DAY BEFORE!

### How much am I required to do?


- We are requiring that you complete a MINIMUM of 20 practice questions for each objective. And...
- You are required to have MASTERY over each objective.
- You access a Mastery Challenge by clicking the upper left hand corner and clicking "Math by subject"



You will then be taken to a page that says, "Continue your personalized Math Mission". Click on this link.



• On the top row you will see a "Mastery Challenge" button where you just click on "Start" to begin a challenge.




 Any objective that you have practiced will show up to be tested, along with some other very easy math skills.

#### **PROGRESS:**

• Your teachers will be monitoring your progress every week to see how much you have completed. Expect to get an email if you have gone two weeks without doing any work.

• You can see your own progress by looking under your student profile and clicking the "progress" tab.



### **REWARDS:**

If you complete all of your summer review work by August 5<sup>th</sup> you will earn a prize when you return to school! We have some pretty awesome gift cards!

#### CONSEQUENCES:

If you DO NOT complete all of your summer review work by the time school starts you will have a **Saturday school detention** until all the work is complete.
