Small Group Homework (LEADERSHIP GUIDE)

For the Week of November 2, 2014 (Questions and Scriptures for further study)

MAIN IDEA: Alex Gilpin taught about living an incarnational life. Incarnation means to take on flesh. We should follow the example of Christ and His ministry, reaching people on "their turf." God is actively at work. Will we join Him in what He is already doing?

QUICK REVIEW

1. Looking back over last weekend's message, what point, illustration, or idea did you need to hear most?

GETTING TO KNOW YOU

2. This weekend's message made us think about "how" the gospel is presented on mission. How was the gospel presented to you? *This is a great time for you to open up, as a leader, about how the gospel was presented to you and how you responded at first.

INTO THE BIBLE

3. Hugh Halter says, "The incarnational life is offered to everybody, but very few will take it. It doesn't come easy, it doesn't come without a choice, it doesn't come without faith, it doesn't come without a leap. WHAT IF actually following Jesus means that when you walk out the door of your house every morning you actually get to see what God is doing and participate, you literally get to be GOOD NEWS. I would definitely sign up for that."

What can you draw from this quote?

What might God be doing around you already and asking you to participate in? *We want people to realize that God is at work all around them doing His part. Will we do ours? Where is He already working that we may have been ignoring?

4. So let's spend some time looking at how Jesus lived out his mission. Look up the following references and write out the corresponding subjects: *The whole point of this exercise is for people to see that Jesus did His ministry "out and about." What we see is that Jesus' ministry had no set form, it often didn't happen the same way twice, he didn't always instigate the conversation and it almost always was on THEIR TURF!
