

2013 RCC KIDS' SUMMER SPIRITUAL JOURNEY

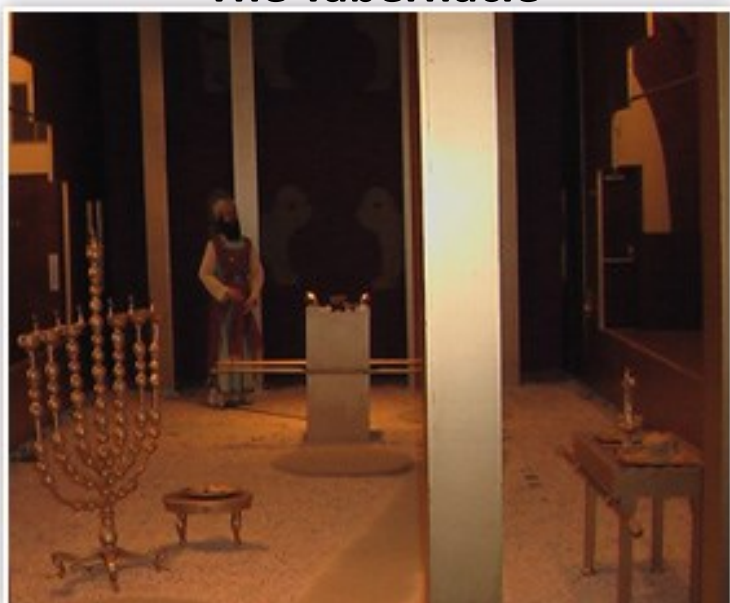
