Online Bill Pay

The leadership of DCV feels that it is the role of the giver to give generously and to proactively engage in the act of giving - regardless of the frequency and purpose of the gift being given. Types of Automated Giving Available

FAQ: How do I set up DCV for online payment?

Online bill pay can help you manage your contributions (tithe/offering) without having to worry about paper checks. This sheet covers how you can set up online bill pay quickly and easily for your DCV contributions.

Answer: Setting up online bill pay is easy. First you'll want to make sure you know what type of online bill pay you have available, and then complete the steps.

This type of online bill pay (online bill pay offered by your bank) is a service that sends money from your bank account to whomever you wish – in this case DCV. In our case your online bill pay services will actually print a check and mail it to DCV.

To set up this type of online bill pay you'll probably just need to add DCV as a PAYEE. In your online bill pay account, set up a new payee named "Delaware City Vineyard". Enter the office address - "30 Troy Road, Delaware OH 43015". Please use the 'memo' or comment area to indicate how your check is to be applied such as "GF" for tithes and offerings, "FEED" for food pantry, "RTC" for Right Type of Crazy Campaign. If you want to give to multiple accounts, your memo should look something like 200 GF/ 100 RTC / 50 FEED. Each time you want to make a contribution, just enter the amount, place note in the memo field, submit and you're done. The bank will print and mail a check that will debit money from your account.

Automatic Online Bill Pay

If you really like to automate things so that you don't have to think about them, you can automate online bill pay. Almost all online bill pay services will allow you to set up recurring payments. We would recommend this for individuals and families who have a constant income each week or month.
