Program Details

- **Program Dates:** October 14, 2013 – June 30, 2014
- **Coaching Schedule:** Weekly coachings take place for the entire term from October to June. Coaching dates and times are determined upon admission into the program and are based on coach and group availability.
- **Performances:** Each group is selected to perform in numerous RMC performance opportunities during the course of the term. Such opportunities include the annual recitals, special events, and outreach projects.
- **Monthly Coaching Fee:** \$100 per member per each month.
The fixed coaching fee will be billed at the beginning of each month, with a prorated amount being billed for the initial month of October.
