LATEST NEWS FROM THE SVdP FOOD PANTRY

The pantry netted \$240.00 from the May 20th Culver's promotion, and even included some straight donations (one from Culver's), translating to \$1000 spent by our supporters. THANKS to everyone able to help! In May, the pantry served 182 clients representing 510 people (223 children); our dedicated volunteers were put to the test. Food items you might shop for, include MAC 'N CHEESE, SPAGHETTI, SOUP, CANNED BEANS, CRACKERS (boxes with sleeves of crackers), PASTA SIDES. Remember, glass and large cans are problematic because of weight and breakability, but we'll certainly use them.
