Check out this post from Eric McArdle about comfort and stewardship:

We all want to be comfortable. We want air conditioning when it's hot and we want food when we're hungry. We want the most advanced mattress so we have a great night's sleep. In our country, in this day and time, we are not likely to go without those things that bring comfort. We really don't have to.

Yet, as stewards, we know firsthand that we should not expect comfort in this life. We should be prepared for challenges and trials. When we step outside our comfort zone, when we strive for greatness as stewards no matter the obstacle, and when we turn to God during life's trials, tackling these challenges only makes us stronger.

In his address during World Youth Day in Spain in 2011, Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI summed up these thoughts when he proclaimed: "The world promises you comfort. But you were not made for comfort. You were made for greatness!" Heed these wise words...

Stewardship tells us to give of our first fruits, our best gifts, same as the Holy Spirit called to those present at the first meeting of the Church during Pentecost. In doing so, we can attain this greatness that Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI speaks of. Don't settle just for comfortable, make life great.
