Bendiciones para todos Uds. El Domingo pasado, que fue el siguiente a la celebración de la gloriosa resurrección de Nuestro Señor Jesús Cristo celebramos, a nivel mundial, la fiesta de la Divina Misericordia, como decreto del Santo Padre, San Juan Pablo II. En este mensaje, que Nuestro Señor nos ha hecho llegar por medio de Santa Faustina, se nos pide que tengamos plena confianza en la Misericordia de Dios, y que seamos siempre misericordiosos con el prójimo a través de nuestras palabras, acciones y oraciones... "porque la fe sin obras, por fuerte que sea, es inútil" (Diario, 742).

Aunque la conmemoración del Domingo de la Divina misericordia ya pasó la misericordia en sí continúa. El Señor la continúa derramando su perdón y conversión a los que la piden de corazón. 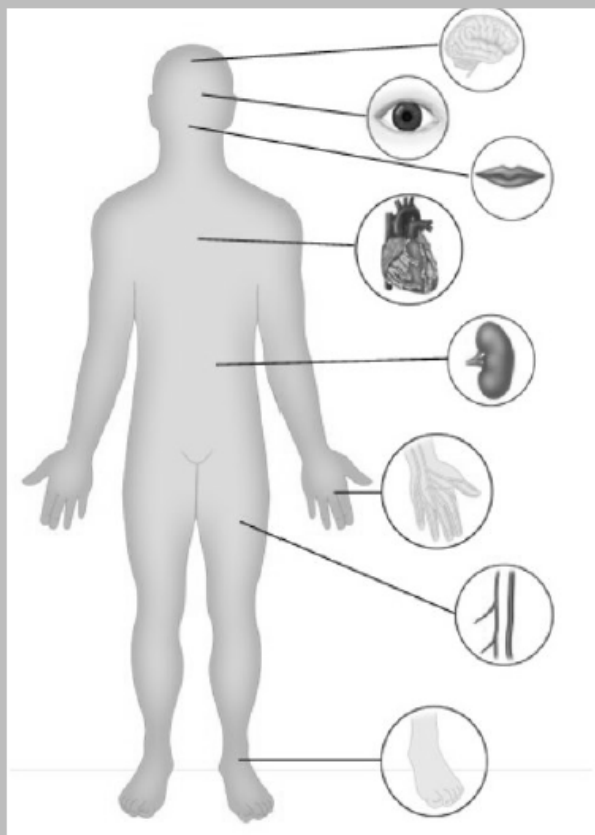

DIOCESAN REQUIREMENTS FOR REPORTING MINISTRY RELATED SEXUAL ABUSE OF A MINOR

- 1) All cases of alleged, known or suspected ministry related abuse of minor must be reported to the proper civil authority. Any person having actual knowledge of, or reasonable cause to suspect an incident of ministry related sexual abuse by any church personnel of the Diocese of Charlotte is to immediately report the incident to the Chancery, unless to do so would violate the Sacrament of Penance. The Chancery will then report the incident to the proper civil authority. After notifying the proper civil authority, the Chancery will immediately notify the Assistance Coordinator, the Promoter of Justice, and the Review Board. Following this, the individual reporting the incident to the Chancery will be notified of the particulars regarding the filing of the incident with the civil authority. This reporting requirement is not intended to supersede the right of a victim or witness to individually make a report to public authorities, but is to ensure proper, complete and timely reporting to the proper civil authority. At the time of reporting, the diocese will request to be kept informed as to the progress of that authority's investigation. Should an individual choose to make a report to civil authorities, the requirement to make report to the Chancery is not removed.
- 2) A lack of information, or the lack of consent of the alleged victim, the victim's parent(s), or legal guardian, or the person(s) providing the information is not to prevent the immediate reporting of the allegation of abuse to civil authorities.
- 3) At the time of reporting an incident of alleged sexual misconduct to the Chancery, the person making the report will be asked to complete the diocesan form: **Report of Suspected Ministry Related Sexual Misconduct by Church Personnel**.
- 4) Any act of retaliation or discrimination against an individual who reports or complains of ministry related sexual misconduct is strictly prohibited and will not be tolerated by the Diocese of Charlotte.

REQUISITOS DE LA DIOCESE PARA REPORTAR UNA OFENSO O ABUSO SEXUAL

- 1) Toda persona que tenga conocimiento personal sobre la commission de un acto impropio de índole sexual cometido por una persona empleada por la Diócesis de Charlotte deberá reportar el caso inmediatamente a la Cancillería, a menos que al hacerlo se viole el Sacramento de la Penitencia. La Cancillería deberá reportar el caso a las autoridades civiles competentes.
- 2) Toda persona que reporte un caso de possible conducta sexual impropia deberá llenar un formulario llamado **Report of Suspected Ministry Related Sexual Misconduct by Church Personnel**.
- 3) La Diócesis de Charlotte no tomará acción alguna en contra de una persona que haya sido acusada anónimamente o si la acusación no ha podido ser corroborada. La persona acusada recibirá una notificación sobre la acusación y sobre la decisión de la Diócesis.
- 4) Está terminantemente prohibido todao acto de represalia en contra de una persona que haya presentado una acusación de conducta sexual impropia en contra de un empleado de la Diócesis de Charlotte.
