Pastor's Message

How history and presence inspire our future.



When you open the front doors of our church, have you felt the hand-forged iron handles in your hand? They are the work of Tom Latane, a renown artist/metalsmith. HGTV came by and featured them as being as unique as any door handle on any Gothic Cathedral in all of Europe. The handle on the left represents St. Paul and tradition and wisdom. He is holding a Bible. On the right is St. Mark representing youth and piety, with hands in prayer.

The feel of the iron handles not only provide a sense of permanence, they inspire us to live and be with the saints gathered.

The bronze statue of Ruth in the narthex was created by Scott Frenzel, the grandson of the Manthe family, charter members of Saint Mark back in 1898. Ruth is the great-grandmother of King David and is included in the lineage of Jesus. She represents faithfulness, those new to the faith, immigrants, femininity, morality and education. The book of Ruth has been taught in college English classes as the classic short story. Every Sunday, we light the candle she holds, to be inspired by her wisdom.
