

Council was pleased to have Pastor Tim Philips join us for the April Council meeting.

The kitchen has been permitted by the County Health Department to prepare food for public consumption, such as Trinity Center. This is not a full service permit.

Council approved several recommendations made by the Saint Matthew Foundation in regards to adding another memorial plaque to the memorial garden, cost for lines on the memorial plaques, and a modest increase in the price for single and double niches.

The Easter offering was distributed among Young Life Former Soviet Union, Young Life Diablo Valley (Capernaum), and Mission Beyond Saint Matthew Restricted Fund. Funding for Trinity Center was approved. On Family Worship Sundays, a Change for Change children's offering will be collected.

Currently expenses are outpacing our income. Our revenue is \$26,108 less than our expenses. This deficit is expected to grow given that we now have an interim pastor.
