

Hello! I thought I would give you an update. Now that we aren't driving to Camdenton every week, I'd hoped to find more time, but somehow Murphy's Law of the Clock is proving true. Much of what is occupying our time is self-inflicted (but necessary).

Last week I finished translating 75 pages of course notes on Animism and Folk Religion for the training program in Spanish and sent it to Edwin in Mexico. His response was both an encouragement when he said, "...Truly, thank you so much for the translated notes. I'm going to start class that class (animism) in a week. Wow! Thank the Lord."

The course he just finished was on World View, regarding the "lens" through which a culture interprets, understands and explains the world where they live. I'm pretty sure the notes I translated on that subject were a part of his teaching as well. I know the translation will need a LOT of editing... any translation does. But my goal isn't perfection. at this point we just want to get this material into the capable hands of these trainers so the Spirit of God can use them to prepare more workers.

I have now started translating notes on the cultural concept of honor and shame. We all know the concept about "losing face" in eastern societies, but I'm working on the subject of how the concept of honor and shame is manifested in the latin culture. I am amazed at how deeply the concept affects my latino friends. It's written by someone from the outside, so I'm anxious to see how my latino brothers see it. I wish I had it 30 years ago when we were starting up in Mexico.

Once again Jeri and I want to express that you are so very important in helping us continue with this task. THANK YOU FOR YOUR PART!
