Buckhead Christian Ministry (BCM) prevents hunger and homelessness for people facing life-changing events, such as job loss and illness. BCM provides emergency and housing assistance and life-skills education, placing special emphasis on the needs of low-income workers. BCM fosters community by engaging volunteers in bringing hope and compassion to people of all faiths.

- BCM's **Emergency Assistance Program** helps people in crisis by providing food, clothing, employment support and one-time assistance paying rent, mortgage or utility bills.
- BCM's **Transitional Housing Program** helps homeless families regain financial stability by providing an apartment, money management education and support services for 18 to 24 months.
- The **70/30 Project** low-income workers become financially stable by providing rent and utility payments, money management education and support services for six months.
- The **Money Management Course** teaches participants the skills they need to become financially stable by coupling classroom learning with one-on-one financial mentoring.
- **Buckhead THRIFTique** provides free clothing to people in crisis and sells affordable clothing to the community.
- At BCM, more than 290 volunteers provide compassionate assistance to people of all faiths who live in 15 Atlanta zip-codes.



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BCM VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

Buckhead Christian Ministry is volunteer-driven, a united collection of neighbors serve each other. Our volunteers provide compassionate service to clients and assist with fundraising, administration and leadership. There are many ways you can help:

- **Help Line Volunteers** help clients get the services they need by scheduling appointments, giving directions and providing service referrals.
- **Hospitality Volunteers** create a warm and welcoming environment for our clients, many of whom are in desperate need of a smiling face.
- **Intake Volunteers** interview people who come to our door seeking help and work with staff to provide them with food, clothing, financial assistance and access to other service providers. Time commitment: one three-hour shift per month.
- **Money Management Coaches and Trainers** teach clients to set a household budget, create and use bank accounts, and other basic skills for managing money. Trainers teach money management courses and coaches work one-on-one with families to apply what they learn in the class. All training materials are provided; *no financial expertise is required*.
- **Buckhead THRIFTique Volunteers** assist customers and help people in need select clothing for interviews and everyday wear. They also sort and price clothes, arrange displays and operate the cash register.
- **Administrative and Data Entry Volunteers** help keep BCM running smoothly by answering the phone, filing, entering data into various data banks, assisting with mailings and performing other administrative duties.
- **Food Pantry Volunteers** keep the pantry organized by accepting donations and packing bags of food.
- **Fundraising Volunteers** help BCM gain special event sponsorships, collect auction items and introduce BCM to new friends.
- **Special Events Volunteers** help plan and/or staff events such as Joyous Toys, The Annual Appreciation Dinner, The Buckhead Golf Classic and 'Tis the Season. These events provide funding for BCM's programs and help us celebrate with our partners, clients and volunteers.
- **Group Volunteering** is available in The BCM Food Pantry and Buckhead THRIFTique and for special projects.
