2014 Adult Retreat Registration Opens!

Meeting Christ at the Crossroads of the Gospels is the theme of our 2014 Adult Retreat to be led by Dr. Tom Long on Jan. 31-Feb 2 at the luxurious Bishop's Lodge in Santa Fe, NM.

Tom Long is a speaker, preacher, and teacher in great demand across the nation. He serves as the Bandy Professor of Preaching at Candler School of Theology at Emory University in Atlanta, Georgia. Tom received his B.A. and M.Div. from Erskine Seminary and his Ph.D. from Princeton Theological Seminary in 1980. He began his career as a preacher at McElroy Presbyterian Church near Atlanta, Georgia, and since that time has taught at a number of seminaries, including

Princeton and Candler.

In 1996, Dr. Long was named one of the 12 most effective preachers in the English speaking world by Baylor University, along with the likes of Fred Craddock, Billy Graham, James Forbes, Barbara Brown Taylor, and William Willimon. Just "Google" his name to get a glimpse of his usual venues. We are so fortunate to have him come be with us!

Dr. Long will be leading us in a Bible study of the four gospels and the unique revelations they each give us of the person and message of Jesus Christ. **Sign up this Sunday at the table in the hallway for this life-changing event!**


