






Team Up

We have had a successful year with our Team Up Program. We were in 4 schools this yr in 3 parishes! We served 163 students this year in this program. The program is a Faith Based Therapeutic Leadership program conducted by Licensed Counselors in Public Schools. School counselors choose the students that will participate and Seeker Springs Staff conduct a 7 week program in the schools using our portable ropes challenge course initiatives. At the end of the program, students and their parents are invited to Seeker Springs to experience the "Real" Ropes Course. Reports from parents and teachers tell us that this is a life changing program for these students as they learn communication skills, problem solving, decision making, relationship skills, and leadership. They often refer to their faith as a foundation for answers to life's problems.
