

Arriving at Camp

- Registration is in the Recreation Center with lines forming on the pool deck. Parking is available in the athletic field.
- Please have final payment, outstanding paperwork and all medications in their original containers ready upon arrival at Registration.
- Checks should be made payable to "Seneca Hills". Please direct any questions about the balance due, cabin mate, dietary and special needs to the Office prior to Registration Day.
- Offering envelopes will be collected during Registration.
- Church scholarship payments should include the camper's name. If the church is to be billed, the camper must bring a church scholarship certificate to validate the scholarship amount.
- If you need to pick up your child mid-day for any reason or early at the conclusion of the day, please complete the necessary paperwork at Registration Station #1.
- After Registration, a parent or guardian must escort the camper to their cabin and sign the check-in form. At that time indicate if someone else will be picking up the camper at the conclusion of camp.

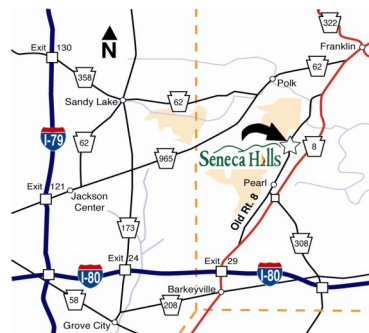
Arrival & Departure Times

- Registration the first day of camp begins at 8:15 AM.
- Every day following the first day, Day Camp begins at 9:00 AM. Please bring Day Campers to the Recreation Center.
- Every day, Day Camp ends at 5:00 PM. Campers will be in the Recreation Center for pickup.

Last Day of Camp

- Please park in the athletic field and wait outside the Dining Hall area for campers to be dismissed.
- Seneca Outfitters, the camp store, will be open at the conclusion of camp for souvenir purchases. Cash, checks and credit cards are accepted.
- The summer camp evaluation form has moved online to our website. Please complete and submit the quick and easy online form to let us know your thoughts on the week of camp.
- Encourage your child to check the Lost & Found and unclaimed craft projects as you leave. Unclaimed items are given away to local charities.
- Parents or the previously designated person must sign out each camper prior to leaving camp.
- The Camp Nurse will return all unused medications as part of the departure process.

In Your Confirmation Packet

Review your **Confirmation Letter** to make sure you are registered for the correct week of camp. Outstanding balances are due at Registration.

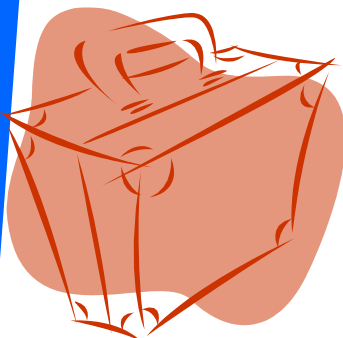


Don't forget to mail in your completed Health & Waiver Form prior to camp!

The enclosed **Health and Waiver Form** must be completed for every camper, **including adults attending Camp With Me**. To expedite the registration process, mail your completed form at least one week prior to your week of camp.

The enclosed **Seneca Hills Offering** envelope will be collected at Registration and is used to subsidize the ministry of "Making Him Known". Your financial and prayer support are vital to the ministry of Seneca Hills as the fee for summer camp only covers one-half of actual costs.

The enclosed **Missions Offering** envelope is collected at Registration and given to the missionaries serving during your week at camp to support their work. The daily Missions Session provides campers a unique opportunity to learn about world-wide missions.

What NOT to Pack

- Food, snacks, candy and gum
- Electronics including cell phones, iPods and games
- Money
- Inappropriate clothing for camp (includes two-piece bathing suits, short shorts and clothes with questionable slogans)

Camper Accounts

Campers are encouraged to have a Camper Account which can be used throughout the week for purchases. These prepaid accounts allow campers to enjoy their week without needing to have cash on hand. Funds for the account can be sent with camper deposits or included with final payment on Registration Day. Unused balances will be refunded at the end of camp. Primary and Camp With Me

campers do not need prepaid accounts as snacks and crafts are included in their cost of camp.

Seneca Outfitters

The Seneca store will be open at the conclusion of camp daily and offers SH clothing and souvenirs. The store accepts cash, checks, and credit cards.

Snackery

Snacks are \$0.75 each, and campers may purchase two snacks at each snack time. The Snackery is open once a day during Day Camp times.

Craft Barn

Certain craft projects are included in the cost of camp. Additional crafts are available for sale in the Craft Barn and range in price from \$1 to \$10.

Camper Insurance

Seneca Hills provides secondary insurance for accidents and illnesses that occur at camp and coverage for uninsured campers. It is the policy of Seneca Hills Bible Conference to inform parents or legal guardians of a camper's illness or injury in the following Situation; If the illness or injury requires the camper to be seen by medical personnel other than the camp nurse, you will be contacted to take your child to your health care provider. Pre-existing conditions are not covered.

Camper Medication

All medications, except inhalers and epipens, must be given to the Camp Nurse at Registration. Medications must be in their original containers with the camper's name attached. Parents or guardians must sign a release for medications, including over-the-counter drugs. Please direct any questions to the Camp Nurse during Registration.
