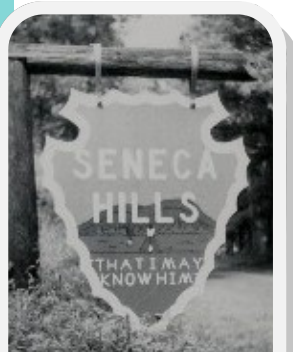

### Family Camp Details

- Seneca Hills is a drug, alcohol, arms and fireworks free facility. All buildings are smoke free. Violators will be asked to leave.
- Entering the housing of others without their permission is not permitted.
- Please do not sit or stand on any railings.
- Lost & Found is located in the Dining Hall behind the podium.
- Please help to keep camp clean by not littering and picking up any litter you may see.
- During Family Camp, our media staff will be taking pictures for use in publicity pieces. If for

any reason you do not grant permission for you or a mem-

ber of your family to be photographed, please contact a member of the Executive Staff.

- Quiet hours are to be observed from 11 pm to 7 am. Please be respectful of others around you.

## **Vehicles / Parking / Bikes**

- The camp speed limit is 4 miles per hour.
- When moving vehicles, please be alert to pedestrians and bikers in the area.
- Keep your vehicle locked when unattended.
- Please refrain from driving around campus during the weekend, especially during rainy weather. A courtesy cart will be available for rides.
- Parking is available along the lower lane and behind Pine Lodge. Please do not park in front of the Dining Hall or offices.
- Bikes are welcome below the lower lane and should be ridden only during daylight hours.

## **Emergencies / First Aid**

- Report all emergencies to a Seneca Hills Staff member.
- Please accompany children to the First Aid Station, located next to the Office.
- For ambulance service, dial 911.

## **Day Guests**

- All visitors must stop at the Registration Tent to register and receive a guest bracelet. Day guest donations are appreciated.
- Meals are available for day guests at \$5 per person per meal if space allows in the Dining Hall. Please register and pay for meals at the Registration Tent.

## **Telephone**

- A telephone is available in the Office.
- Please call collect or use a calling card.

## **Activities**

- The bell will ring prior to all activities.
- A family craft is available to purchase in the Craft Barn.
- Miniature golf is to be played with adult supervision.
- The pool is only to be used during scheduled hours with a lifeguard on duty.
- The Challenge Course and Climbing Room are to be used only with direct supervision of the Seneca Hills Staff.
- Day guests are invited to eat in the Dining Hall as space allows. Please sign up and pay in advance at the Registration Tent.
- The Recreation Center is not open during Chapel and Missions services.

## **Child Care**

- During unscheduled times, please do not leave your children unsupervised.
- Children's programs are scheduled during Chapel and Missions meetings except for Sunday's Chapel service.

- Please bring your children to the assigned location for sign-in as follows.

Ages 0 to 3—MRC meeting room

Ages 4 to 7—Pine Lodge

Ages 8 to 12—Pine Lodge (Mid-session pickup in the Recreation center.)

- Children over age 12 are expected to attend Chapel and Mission services with their parents.

## **Dining Hall / Snack Time**

- Please inform the Registration Tent workers if you will not be attending any scheduled meals.
- Day guests are invited to eat in the Dining Hall as space allows. Please sign up and pay in advance at the Registration Tent.
- All guests, including those cooking their own meals in the campground, are invited to the evening snack.

## **Campground**

- Campers, trailers and tents in pre-reserved spots may be set up Thursday at the earliest without prior approval. Specific sites are available for reservation by calling the office.
- Bathrooms and showers are located in the ground floor of the Miller Retreat Center or in the Recreation Center.
- Limited picnic tables are available for use in Harmony Pavilion. However, we recommend that you bring your own.
- One bundle of firewood is included with your campground registration. Additional firewood will be available for \$5 per bundle at the Registration Tent. Please consider attending the Firewood Hour to help replenish the consumed wood.
- All campfires are to be extinguished after use and should never be left unattended.

## **Miller Retreat Center & Cabins**

- Please read the cabin rules and emergency procedures posted in your residences.
- Locate the nearest exits and fire ladders in your sleeping areas.

## **Pets**

- Due to the large number of people attending family camp, pets are discouraged from attendance.
- Pets are only permitted in the campground area on leashes or tethers and are not permitted in any buildings.
- Owners are responsible for their pets at all times. Please clean up pet waste immediately.

## **Repairs / Maintenance Issues**

- Please help us maintain our facilities by reporting any items in need of repair.
- For non-emergency items, please use the "Hot Sheet" hanging on a clipboard outside the Office.
- If the situation warrants immediate attention, please contact a staff member.
